June 6th and 7th are *Free Fishing Days* in New Jersey. On those 2 days any one can fish without a license. To celebrate, the Pack will be holding a Fishing Derby on Sunday June 7th at Amwell Lake. Hold the Date. Details to follow.

Summer Camping at Kittatinny Mountain Scout Reservation

The Central Jersey Council is sponsoring several camping events this summer, and Pack 32 will be joining them. There are 3 camping opportunities that we will be participating in as a Pack that will give your scout the chance to enjoy the outdoors and make new friends.

The first is the **Cub/Parent Weekend** where a parent and their Scout (Tiger through Webelos) will spend a weekend together camping at KMSR. Campers check in at 1:00pm on Saturday and then participate in a day of activities that include rowing, swimming, cooking, archery and BB guns (Archery & BB guns are run by certified instructors). After a satisfying dinner you'll have a chance to hang around the camp fire and catch up with old friends and make new ones. At 10:00pm it's off to bed, and then on Sunday morning there's breakfast and non-denominational services. After patches are presented, we pack up for home at 10:30am.

The fee for the Cub/Parent weekend is \$80 - \$40 for each additional scout or parent.

For scouts, of all ranks, that would like to spend a little more time at camp, there is a **4-day Mini-Resident Camp**. This camp offers a variety of activities such as games, crafts, sports, scout skills, and much, much more. All activities are supervised by camp staff and volunteer leaders and provide advancement through Cub Scouting. Adults can attend if they volunteer to be a leader and their scout will receive a discounted fee.

The fee for the Mini-Resident camp is \$160 (before May 1st); \$125 if the parent volunteers to be a Leader.

Webelos Resident Camp is a week-long program designed for boys entering their first or second year of Webelos. They'll enjoy all of the activities of the min-resident camp, plus other activities geared toward their rank. These include advanced training in BB guns and archery, advanced swimming and boating, and advanced climbing. In addition, they'll have the chance to cook over an open fire, build a shelter and learn [how](#) to survive in the great outdoors.

The fee for the Webelos Resident Camp is \$250 (before May 1st); \$225 if the parent volunteers to be a Leader.

Pack 32 will be participating on the follow dates - other dates are available, but we will not be participating as a Pack:

- Cub Parent Weekend – August 8th & 9th
- Mini-Resident Camp – August 9th – 12th
- Webelos Resident Camp – August 9th – 15th
